New Preschool Regulations

You may have read in the media about issues in Early Childhood services in Victoria. To continue to safeguard our youngest students the Early Childhood Authority has made changes to a number of regulations, one which is Regulation 168 around the taking and storage of photos of our students. The changes to Regulation 168 require preschools to have a policy and procedures for the safe use of digital technologies and online environments at the service. Our Preschool staff are implementing new documentation that outlines the following:

- the taking, use, storage and destruction of images and videos of children
- obtaining authorisation from parents to take, use and store images and videos of children
- the use of any digital device issued by the service
- the use of digital devices by children

Parents have been asked to sign a new permission note for student photos and online use. There are four permissions needed now, and this information is safely stored. If you haven't signed the new photo permission form, please see Miss Sam, the Preschool teacher, or reach out to Miss Martin and they can provide the permission note for you.

K- 2 Athletics Day

On Tuesday 9th September 2025 we will be holding our annual P-2 Sports Day in the school playground. All students in K-2 and the Preschool (Blue group) will be participating. They will need to wear their sports uniform, school hat and sneakers on that day.

The activities will begin at 11:45am and will run until 2:45pm. All students will be actively engaged throughout the day, rotating through a range of activities run by class teachers. The age races of approx. 50m will be held after recess at 1:45pm.

Students will be having recess at the normal time of 1.25pm -1.45pm. Families are welcome to come along and support their child/children on the day. Parents and Carers will be welcomed through the school gate from 11.40am. You are welcome to have a picnic recess, within the sectioned off area on the lower grass playground, with your own child/children ONLY (K-2 students).

If your child cannot participate due to illness or injury on the day, please provide a note to your child's teacher.

Online Issue with Students

We can help our children safely navigate the online world by taking some basic steps to reduce the risks. Please read below information from The eSafety Commissioner website regarding online issues of bullying, which is an ever-growing issue amongst our students outside of the school gates.

Our support and guidance can give our children the knowledge to make sound decisions online and the confidence to ask for help when they need it.



Three key strategies:

Be engaged, open and supportive

- Get involved with your child's online activities as a family. Play games together. Talk about favourite apps, games or websites.
- Keep lines of communication open. Ask about their online experiences, who they are talking to and whether they are having any issues.
- Reassure your child they can always come to you, no matter what. Your child may not communicate openly about things that worry them online if they fear being in trouble if they tell you. Let them know you will not cut off internet or device access if they tell you they're feeling uncomfortable or unsafe online.
- If you notice a change in your child's behaviour or mood, talk with them about it. If you are concerned, consider seeking professional help – from your GP, a psychologist or school counsellor.

Set some rules

- Set rules for devices and online access, with consequences for breaking them. As they grow in online skills and maturity you can review your rules together.
- Get your child's input — this will help them understand risks.
- Model behaviour that you would like to see. Children will be more likely to follow rules if they see you doing the same.
- Consider creating a family tech agreement (sometimes called a family media plan or family online safety agreement). This is a set of rules about how devices are used in your home as well as what acceptable online behaviour looks like. eSafety has created downloadable templates for families with children under 5 or those with children aged 5 to 8 years. For families with older children, The Family Online Safety Contract from ThinkUKnow Australia is a good starting point.

Use safety features and settings

- Get to know the devices you and your children use and set them up for privacy and online safety. Take advantage of parental controls to monitor and control screen time and access to content, based on your child's age and experience. See our guide to parental controls.
- Choose apps and games carefully and visit the App Store or Google Play for age ratings and consumer advice.
- Refer to our advice about screen time and online gaming if these are of concern.
- The eSafety Guide provides valuable information about the latest games, apps and social media, including how to protect your personal information and report harmful content.
- You can visit the eSafety Commissioner webpage for information about movies, apps, games and websites, searchable by age.

Children 5 to 12

As children start to navigate the online world and interact with others more independently, they are more likely to be exposed to risks of bullying or unsafe contact, to accidentally come across content not designed for children or overspending on in-app purchases.

Your guidance can help them watch for risks and understand what is expected of them. Let them know you are always there to support them.

For ways to start conversations about online safety and difficult topics like child sexual abuse online, see our advice for talking with children aged 0 to 12.

Advice for parents and carers

- Keep the computer or device in an area of your home that can be supervised. Check in regularly with your child to see what they are viewing.
- Stay engaged with their online activity. Consider setting up your own accounts with the sites they use most, or simply browsing the content, so you can see how they work and understand the risks. Show good privacy habits by asking your child before sending them a 'friend' or follow request. If they say they don't want to connect with you online, it may be a good opportunity to talk about risks and rules.
- Explore the online world with them to help establish that you can share online activities as a family. You might want to play games with them or do a creative project together.
- Think about social media readiness. Most social media sites require users to be at least 13 years old before they can register, although some sites are created especially for children under 13.
- Encourage respect and empathy. Teach your child to avoid sharing or posting things that may upset others.
- Start building resilience. Explain to your child that there are ways they can deal with material that worries or frightens them. This includes immediately telling you or another trusted adult of any concerns or uncomfortable material.

Technology tips for parents of children 5 to 12 years

- Ensure your own devices are protected by a password or PIN, so your child can't accidentally come across content not intended for children.
- If you are thinking about giving them their own tablet or smartphone, check out '[are they old enough?](#)'
- If your child does have their own device, avoid logging into your own accounts on that device. This will prevent any content you have stored in the cloud that may not be child-friendly from synchronising (downloading or sharing to) your child's device.
- Use parental control tools you feel are right for the age and experience of your child. Be upfront and get your child on board. Let them know these can be reviewed and changed as they get older, if they show responsible behaviour. Consider installing a 'child-friendly' search engine that will allow them to explore a limited number of sites.

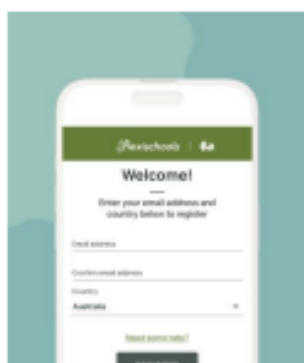
How to set up your Flexischools account

You can also signup through the Flexischools website flexischools.com.au

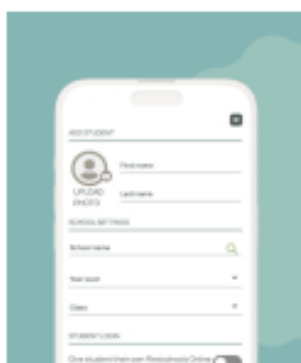


If you already have a Flexischools account you can simply add a new student to your existing account.



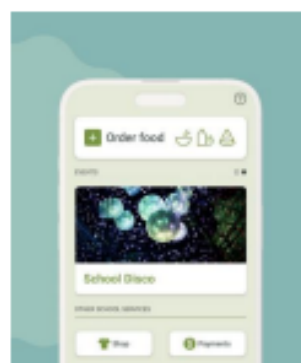
1. Download the app

The Flexischools app is the easiest way to place online lunch orders, buy school uniforms, and receive instant notifications from your school.



2. Register

- Open the Flexischools App and click 'Register'.
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link and follow the registration process.



3. Log in to your Flexischools account and enter your child's details

- Select the 'Profile' icon on the navigation bar.
- Under 'Students', click 'Add new'.
- Enter your child's name, school, year level, and class.
- Click 'submit'.

How to order

- Click the 'Order Food' button at the top of the home page.
- Select which student you would like to place the order for.
- Choose which service, and date you would like to place the order for.
- Make your selections by adding items
- Click "View Order", then "Checkout & Pay"

Tip: Pay-as-you-go for each order, or top-up your Flexischools Wallet.

Student Login

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

Cancelling your order

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

Fee & Charges

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App. This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to [view instructions](#).
