Student Access to NSW EduChat in Term 4

NSW EduChat is a generative artificial intelligence (GenAl) tool and is owned and designed by the NSW Department of Education.

We are excited to share that all students in Years 5 to 12 will soon be able to use NSW EduChat; a cutting -edge generative Artificial Intelligence chat tool. NSW EduChat promotes equitable learning opportunities by providing students with a free, safe and effective GenAl tool. NSW EduChat will be made available to all Year 5 to Year 12 students in NSW public schools from Term 4 2025. It is designed to be:

- -Secure and private
- -Safe
- -Educational

The Department has taken measures to make NSW EduChat a safe and beneficial educational tool. NSW EduChat employs a comprehensive and multi-layered content filtering system, to ensure interactions remain appropriate and educational.

This includes profanity filters, semantic analysis to detect harmful content, and topic restrictions. NSW EduChat has been designed to respond to students with guidance and by asking open-ended questions that encourage them to explore and share their thoughts and reasoning. This approach sets it apart from other GenAl applications, like ChatGPT.

Announcement to Schools

Our school is pleased to announce that we are now using an online lunch ordering system called Flexischools. Australia's #1 school ordering solution, Flexischools, operates in more than 1800 schools across Australia, enabling cashless ordering and payments for schools.

How to set up your Flexischools account

Simply <u>download the Flexischools App</u> from the Apple or Google stores and follow the prompts to create an account.

You can also signup through the Flexischools website flexischools.com.au



If you already have a Flexischools account you can simply add a new student to your existing account.



1. Download the app

The Flexischools app is the easiest way to place online lunch orders, buy school uniforms, and receive instant notifications from your school.







2. Register

- Open the Flexischools
 App and click 'Register'.
- Submit your email address to create an account.
- Go to your inbox and open the registration email from Flexischools.
- Click on the link and follow the registration process.



3. Log in to your Flexischools account and enter your child's details

- Select the 'Profile' icon on the navigation bar.
- Under 'Students', click 'Add new'.
- Enter your child's name, school, year level, and class.
- Click 'submit'.

How to order

- Click the 'Order Food' button at the top of the home page.
- Select which student you would like to place the order for.
- Choose which service, and date you would like to place the order for.
- Make your selections by adding items
- Click "View Order", then "Checkout & Pay"

Tip: Pay-as-you-go for each order, or top-up your Flexischools Wallet.

Student Login

Enter your child's email address so they can order their own lunch through their Flexischools account on their device. It's a great way for them to pick what they want, while you stay in control with daily spending limits and automatic top-ups. Simple and stress-free!

Cancelling your order

Orders can be cancelled through the Flexischools app prior to being sent to the canteen supplier each morning.

To cancel your order click on "Orders" in the Flexischools app and then click on the order you wish to cancel. If the order is still available to cancel, simply click on the cancel button. The full amount of your order will be refunded to your Flexischools Wallet.

If the order is not available to cancel, please contact your canteen supplier directly.

Fee & Charges

A 29c order fee is charged on every order placed through the Flexischools App.

This fee is in addition to the cost of the canteen items and is charged at the time of purchase.

There is an additional surcharge for purchases or account top ups made by credit card, debit card or PayPal which is clearly detailed when you check out or add funds into your wallet. However, parents can top up their Flexischools wallet by Bank Transfer which incurs no surcharge. Click here to view instructions.
