## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

### Attendance

Attendance is a focal point for the Department of Education and as such, Kyogle High School has as well. We have introduced SMS messaging for absences, letters for unexplained absences of three or more days and Year Adviser phone calls home. Additionally, the High Expectations Procedures which include attendance of 80% or higher, have all made a difference. Congratulations to everyone for the 7.4% increase in attendance from this time last year and a 13.2% increase in students attending more than or equal to 90% of the time. Well done and lets keep improving on these numbers!

### Uniform

As we enter the colder months (and the rain!), it is timely to put out the proactive reminder of our uniform expectations. While it is tempting to grab the favourite jumper, students should be wearing full school uniform including the school jumper/jacket/hoodie. ## SCHOOL VACCINATION DATES

### NSW Health School Vaccination Program

In 2025 the following vaccines will be offered:

**Monday 26th May Yr 7 & 10**

**Monday 23rd June Yr 7 & 10**

**Thursday 28th August Catch-up clinic**

**In Year 7**, students are offered free vaccines for diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (whooping cough), (dTpa) and human papillomavirus (HPV).

**In Year 10**, students are offered the meningococcal ACWY vaccine.

Vaccination will only be provided at school if consent has been received.

If your child is in Year 7 or Year 10, you can give consent online for their routine school vaccinations.

#### How to Provide Consent:

1. To complete online consent for your child's school vaccinations, visit the School Vaccination Program online consent portal (<https://engage.health.nsw.gov.au/engage>)
2. For detailed steps on how to provide consent, please refer to the NSW Health webpage How to Provide Consent (<https://www.health.nsw.gov.au/immunisation/Pages/onlineconsent-school-vaccination.aspx>).
3. Follow the steps to log in to your existing ServiceNSW account. This is the same account you may already use to renew your driver's licence. If you don't have a ServiceNSW account, refer to <https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/services/myservicensw-account/how-to-creatan-account> to create one.
4. Update or confirm your personal details in ServiceNSW as required.
5. Complete the School Vaccination Consent Form for your child/ren.

#### You will need to:

- a. Enter your child's personal details
- b. Provide the Medicare card details for you and your child
- c. Read the linked Parent Information Sheet and privacy statement.

- d. Provide consent.

If you or your child do not have a Medicare card, internet access or you are unable to complete the online consent, ask your child's school for a paper consent form.

#### The benefits of providing consent online:

- SMS notification three days before the clinic to remind you of the vaccination day
- easily update your child's details
- receive SMS and/or email notifications when vaccinations are given
- faster upload of vaccination records to the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR).

## **Exciting Update: New Date for the School Social!**

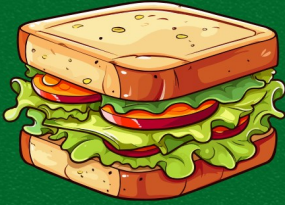

We look forward to seeing everyone in their comfiest pyjamas for an unforgettable night!

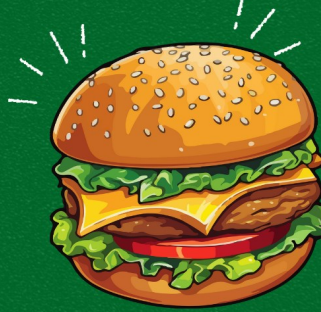


