

The trip began with a visit to the Queensland Museum and SparkLab, where students explored the wonders of electricity through interactive activities, including experiments with circuits and a live demonstration of a Tesla coil.

Next, we travelled to K'gari (Fraser Island), where students deepened their understanding of natural history, by visiting the iconic SS Maheno shipwreck and learning about the island's diverse flora. Highlights included seeing the majestic satinay and brush box trees – some over 1,000 years old! The adventure concluded at Australia Zoo, where students observed a wide variety of animals and gained insights into animal adaptations and wildlife conservation efforts. It was a memorable and educational experience that the students all thoroughly enjoyed.




A huge thank you to all the mums, dads and grandparents who came along to cheer from the sidelines and assist with transport. We truly appreciate your support.





# **Classroom Spotlight**





Spontaneous and self-initiated play is supported and encouraged throughout the day.

This program is subject to change at the discretion of the daily supervisor.

#### **Excursion**

On excursion day, please be at the service 30 minutes before the designated departure time. Excursions are compulsory, and our service is closed on those days.

#### Please ensure that your child:

- · Brings a healthy packed lunch, snacks, a water bottle, hat, and spare clothes for the day. Remember that on cooking days, children will be making their own food to share.
- · All our services have a no-hat, noplaying-outside policy that will be adhered to at all times.
- · It is a workplace health and safety requirement that children wear covered shoes at our services for safe playing.
- Do not bring any electronic devices, including smartwatches, switches, tablets, or mobile phones to our services under any circumstances.

We provide a wide range of fun and engaging activities for all children, and there is no need for your child to bring a device for their own entertainment. If you want to contact your child during the day, you are welcome to call or SMS our service number, and our staff will relay your messages.
