# NGREDIENTS

- . 11/2 cups wholemeal selfraising flour
- · 1 cup reduced fat tasty cheese, grated
- . 3 medium zucchinis, grated, moisture or drained in a squeezed to remove colander
- . 1 medium carrot, grated
- 1 brown onion, finely diced
- · 1 clove garlic, crushed
- · 1/2 teaspoon pepper

# DIRECTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 180 °C. Line a loaf tin with baking paper.

2. Add eggs to large bowl and whisk.

- 3. Add remaining ingredients.
- minutes or until a knife inserted comes out clean. 4. Pour mixture into the tin and bake for 25
- 5. Allow to cool for 10 minutes in the tray before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely.

# INGREDIENTS

- 1 over ripe banana, mashed
- · 1 cup wholemeal self-raising
- 1 egg
- . 3/4 cup milk
- · 1/2 teaspoon vanilla essence (optional)
- Olive oil spray

# DIRECTIONS

- 1. Sift flour into a bowl.
- 2. Add egg and milk and whisk until batter is smooth.
  - 3. Add mashed banana and stir to combine.
- 4. Heat a non-stick frypan on medium heat and lightly spray with olive oil.
- 5. Place heaped tablespoons of batter in the pan and cook for 2 to 3 minutes or until bubbles appear on the surface of each pikelet.
- 6. Gently flip and cook for another 1 to 2 minutes or until golden brown.
- 7. Place pikelets on a plate lined with baking paper and continue to cook until no batter remains.
