Students who need a School travel pass for 2026 can apply at https://transportnsw.info/school-travel-apply.

A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for the first time.

Students who change address, school, have repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should renew or update their details before **the end of Term 4**.

If a student's distance eligibility has changed based on their grade (i.e. grade two to grade three), the system will automatically update their entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new eligibility criteria, you will get an expiry notification via email.




















Term 4 Student **Attendance Draw**


