

# **Lappys**

- Purple Lappys will be tallied for each individual learner in the classroom. These will be handed out by teachers to count towards a learner's tally.
- Yellow Lappys will not be counted in the tally system and will be handed out by support staff, scripture teachers, casual teachers & in the playground.

Both purple and yellow 'Lappys' will be included in:

- weekly Lappy draws, which will occur in class each Friday, where two learners will be drawn for an iceblock/popcorn reward.
- second chance draw, which will occur at the end of each term for a chance to spin the rewards wheel.

## **Learning Disposition Award**

This award is given two learners per class each week who demonstrate one or more of the following learning dispositions:

- Determined
- Collaborative
- Risk Taker
- Reflective
- Resilient
- Creative
- Critical Thinker

## **Aussie of the Month**

This award is given each month to one exceptional learner who demonstrates the following values.

### Criteria:

- Fair go not just how we apply ourselves but providing opportunity for all.
- Mateship generosity of spirit and compassion for those in need.
- Respect of self, others, our community, and the environment.
- Inclusion celebrating of difference and the rights we are entitled to.

All teaching staff to nominate a learner from any class - executive team will review nominations to decide on chosen learner for the month.

#### **Kindness Award**

This award is given each month to one learner per class who demonstrates the following values.

### Criteria:

- Shows understanding and care for others' feelings.
- Expresses appreciation for what they have and the people around them.
- Works with others, especially in group settings or when resolving conflicts.
- Shows mindfulness in their interactions with others.
- Uplifts others around them.
- Regularly demonstrates acts of kindness and resilience in both small and big ways.

Class leaders to nominate a learner from their class with the assistance of their classroom teacher.

#### **Attendance Award**

At the end of each term, all learners who have achieved 95% or higher attendance will receive this award.
