NAPLAN Online 2025 - Year 3 & Year 5 Students

The National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) is a point in time assessment of literacy and numeracy skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and in life. Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 participate in the annual NAPLAN tests in writing, reading, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

Our school will be participating in NAPLAN Online between 12th and 24th March 2025

Students can use the public demonstration site to familiarise themselves with the types of questions and tools available in the NAPLAN Online tests. If you have any questions about NAPLAN Online, exemptions or withdrawals, please contact your child's teacher.

Student Absence


If a student is absent, we ask that you use the school Sentral App.
