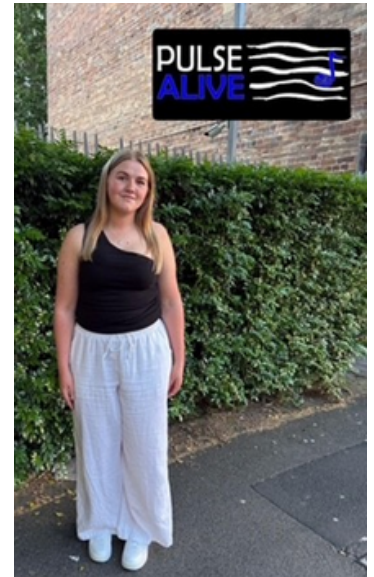
Best wishes to our Year 12 students who commenced their Higher School Certificate Examinations last Thursday. We have every confidence that you will give your very best.

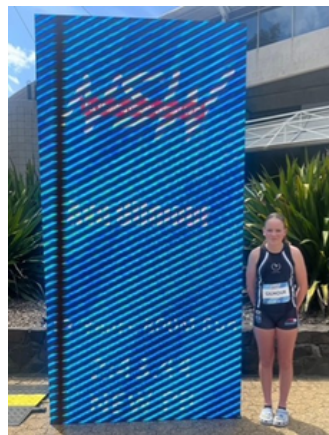
eSports and Sporting Highlights

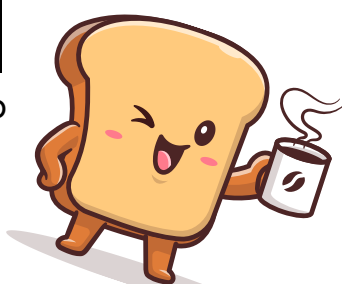
