scheduled in the coming weeks. Exciting times ahead!








HSIE Writing Club – Support and Success

Let's Work Together:


We encourage parents to support their children in preparing for each day's lessons. A quick check the night before can make all the difference in ensuring that students have everything they need.


ATTENDANCE MATTERS

Leeton High School Canteen – The Hungry Hut



How to enrol - Year 6 into Year 7

Step 2 – If you have received an offer from our school for placement into Year 7 next year, the next step is to visit **online enrolment** to proceed with the offer and complete the enrolment application.

If you did not submit an expression of interest or are not eligible, visit **online enrolment** or use the

QR code to start a new application to our school.
