ATTENDANCE MATTERS


It is important that **ALL** student absences are explained within 7 calendar days of the first day of any period of absence.





How to enrol - Year 6 into Year 7

In NSW government schools, applying to move from primary school to high school is a 2-step process that starts with an Expression of Interest. Step 1-Visit the moving to high school page to learn more about the process.

Step 2 - If you have received an offer from our school for placement into Year 7 next year, the next step is to visit **online enrolment** to proceed with the offer and complete the enrolment application.

If you did not submit an expression of interest or are not eligible, visit **online enrolment** or use the

QR code to start a new application to our school.
