#### **Early Drop Off**

We'd like to remind families that there is no teacher supervision at school before 8:40am. Recently, a number of students arriving early have not been following school expectations, which raises concerns around safety and behaviour. If this continues, we will need to ask that families ensure children do not arrive before 8:40am, when a staff member is officially on duty. We appreciate your support in helping us keep all students safe and settled at the start of the school day.



#### **Attendance**

As per the NSW Education Act, all student absences must be explained within 7 days of the first day of absence. We kindly ask families to contact the school promptly whenever your child is away and provide a reason for the absence. This helps us ensure attendance records are accurate and enables us to offer appropriate support where needed. To assist with this process, in addition to the daily absence notifications you already receive, the school will now send a follow-up email twice a week. This email will list any unexplained absences from the previous school days. Parents and carers will then have 7 days from the date of each absence to provide an explanation - after this period, any unexplained absence will remain recorded as such. We appreciate your cooperation in helping us maintain clear and accurate attendance records.

#### **Buddy Reading**

Students from 3/4M have partnered with KH for a special Buddy Reading program. Together, they've been practising reading, writing, and sentence building in fun and engaging ways. The kindy students are thoroughly enjoying the visits from their older buddies twice a week, and it's been wonderful to see friendships forming and learning flourish through this collaboration.







#### **Senior Choir**


#### **PSSA Basketball**
