

Learning in Focus at Lismore Public School

From Mrs Duroux's desk, sharing how teaching and learning comes to life at LPS. This edition focuses on our whole school approach to literacy.





Every morning, students across K-6 join literacy groups that target their reading and spelling needs. This means each child is learning at the right level for them; whether they're learning new sounds, building confidence with reading or strengthening their spelling knowledge.

Teachers regularly collect information about how students are progressing and use this to adjust their teaching. This helps ensure every child gets the right support and challenge to keep moving forward in their reading and spelling.

FROM THE CLASSROOM FLOOR

Students reflected on their learning by giving a score out of five for their confidence in literacy groups, their pride in their progress, and the effort they feel they put into their literacy lessons.













ICAS Awards

The ICAS assessments (International Competitions and Assessments for Schools) are globally recognised tests for primary and secondary students. 
