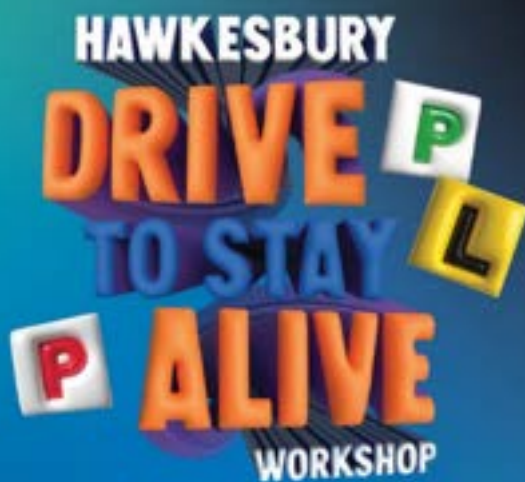
NEXT WEEK
