On Wednesday the senior students from Ganangdayi travelled to Cattai Public School to compete against other students from the Small Schools Network in an Academic Challenge. To say we are proud of their efforts and achievements is an understatement. Each student competed in both a spelling bee challenge and a numeracy challenge in front of an audience of teachers, parents and peers.

After an exciting competition, Elza was awarded first place in the spelling round for Years 3 and 4 while Max won second place in the same category. In the Years 3 and 4 numeracy challenge, Elza finished in second place while Max finished third. Maddie finished in sixth place for both spelling and numeracy in the Year 5 and 6 category, avoiding elimination for several rounds in a highly competitive field.

All of the Mac Valley students shone so brightly today and should be very proud of their outstanding efforts. Simply participating in the challenge was impressive in itself and we congratulate all students on their involvement.

We missed Ashton - who unfortunately could not attend - as we know he would have enjoyed the day as well.


