> During SASS Recognition Week, and every week, we thank you for all you do. You make a real difference in the lives of our students and the entire school community. Kind regards Sarah



Students enjoyed sampling a special gateaux in French lessons this week - miam, miam! Thank you Madame Catherine for always make French so special!


























Year 4/5 students have been making paper mache volcanoes! We look forward to sharing the final results soon!
