Finally, a quick reminder for celebration day: please leave home with enough time to park and walk up to the school for a 1:30pm start.


We can't wait to celebrate 180 incredible years together!

- It's 180 years old
- The school was named Macdonald Valley Public School in 1981.
- The school was originally named Macdonald River School.
- The School was down by the river but it kept getting flooded.
- The school was moved because of the floods - it's hard to teach when it's flooding!
- The building was moved up to its current site in 1956.
- The school bell is the original 1845 bell saved by former principal Robert Harbin and Les Thompson and his family from the floods.
- The school has had as few as 4 students and up to 40 students.
- Over the years we have been on TV, in the newspapers, won international art awards, had art camps and sleepovers...

- The principal, in the old days used to live in a school residence next to the school because it's so far away from anywhere. Now the principal's house is our Day Care.
- The Year 6 boys used to mow the grounds every Friday afternoon.
- A principal in the 60's used to enjoy golf so would practice his chipping and the children had to collect his golf balls from the hill!
