When your child misses just... they miss weeks per year and years over their school life

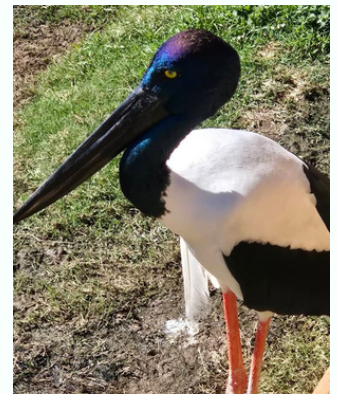
1 day per fortnight = 4 weeks = Over 1 year missed
