# 4/5E CLASSROOM NEWS



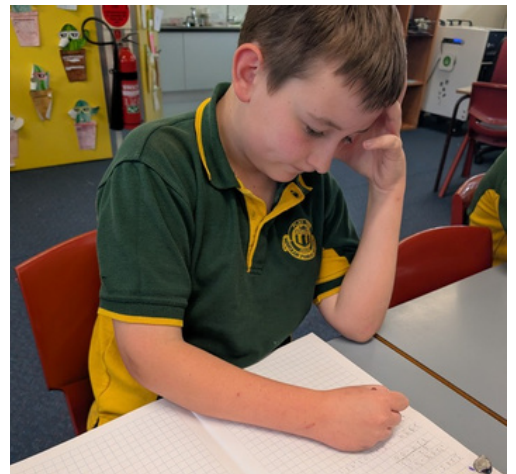
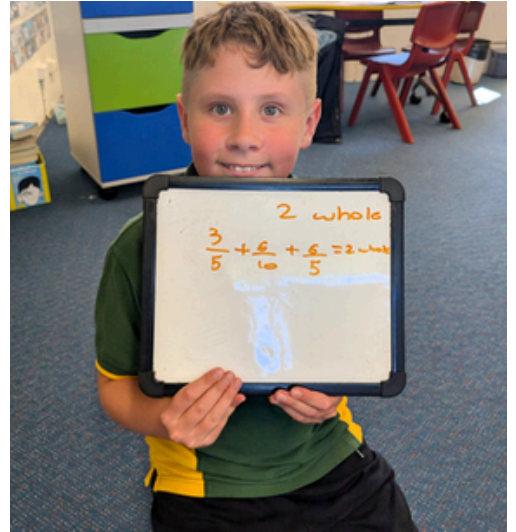
In 4/5E we had a jam-packed Term 3 and have an equally busy term ahead of us!

Our Term 3 English unit linked nicely with our history unit of Australian Colonies. We have learnt a lot about Ned Kelly and his gang. We had to come to a decision on whether we believe Ned was innocent or guilty, which was difficult. We recognised many great arguments for and against him. We then rewrote the Kelly story from the perspective of a gang member. In history we also explored many other perspectives from this era including Maria Lock, Truganini and Mary Reibey. This term we are continuing to look at different perspectives. Beginning with Anh Do and his book "The Little Refugee".

Maths- we have been focused on improving our times tables. We play many times tables-based games with bingo being the fan favourite. This is something we are going to continue working on as it's linked to many of our class tasks including capacity and area.

In sport we really built our skills with both skipping and gymnastics. In gymnastics we loved learning how to do cartwheels, jumps and handstands. Everyone was very supportive of those of us who had fears. In skipping we honed our rhythm, fitness and persistence.
