

## 2T - Term 3 Learning Highlights



Term 3 has been a busy and exciting time in 2T, with students showing great enthusiasm for their learning across all areas.

In English, we have been exploring persuasive texts. Students are beginning to write their own persuasive sentences and practise convincing their audience with strong reasons. In grammar, we've focused on past tense verbs, both regular and irregular, which has helped us strengthen our writing skills.

Mathematics has been very hands-on this term. We have measured the capacity of different containers, explored how to add money, collected data, and practised forming groups of certain amounts. These activities have encouraged lots of problem-solving and discussion in class.

During Sport, we have been participating in gymnastics. Students have enjoyed developing their balance, coordination and strength through a range of fun movement activities.

Our History unit has been a real highlight, as we've been learning about the childhoods of people in the past. Students have loved playing old games and creating some traditional toys, giving them a hands-on experience of how children entertained themselves long ago. We are all looking forward to our excursion to the Kangaroo Valley Pioneer Museum on Thursday to bring this learning to life.

In addition to our academic learning, we've been focusing on building friendships, working as a team and developing a growth mindset.

It has been wonderful to see how engaged and motivated 2T has been this term, and we can't wait to continue our learning journey together.


