Sun Safety Update Information for Parents and Caregivers: For information about sun safety and our sun safe curriculum, policy and procedures, please check the policy section on our school website. You will be able to find information about:

For best sun protection, the Cancer Council recommend a combination of sun protection measures:

- Slip on some sun-protective clothing that covers as much skin as possible.
- Slop on broad spectrum, water resistant SPF30 (or higher) sunscreen. Put it on 20 minutes before you go outdoors and every two hours afterwards. Sunscreen should never be used to extend the time you spend in the sun.
- Slap on a hat broad brim or legionnaire style to protect your face, head, neck and ears. Seek shade. Slide on some sunglasses – make sure they meet Australian Standards.

Thank you to our P&C for continuing to provide free sunscreen for every child in the school. Every child will be provided sunscreen prior to sport and break times during the summer terms. Should your child have an allergy, please provide allergy information to the office in writing, from your medical practitioner.


