Getting serious about driver behaviour

Driver behaviour remains an ongoing concern and this document seeks to inform parents and carers of safety hotspots. The illustrations below should provide a clear guide to our safe kiss and drop zone.

5 x Kiss & Drop

Milton Public School has one Kiss and Drop zone that will fit 5 cars at a time. This zone begins with the **No Parking during school day** sign that is on the right just after the zebra crossing and includes the **No Parking Authorised Vehicles Excepted** area. Shoalhaven City Council has confirmed that you can stop across the driveway in the **No Parking Authorised Vehicles Excepted** area for a Kiss and Drop. You have a maximum of 2 minutes to drop off or pick up your children. The driver is required to remain in, or within 3 metres of your car. On Thursday's, due to police attendance at court, a couple of our Kiss and Drop spots may be unavailable.

Thomas Street (marked with on map)

Thomas Street is a single lane one-way street from the Princes Highway to Wason Street. We ask that you avoid queuing to enter Thomas Street from the highway. It is also essential that you do not queue over the crossing or let your children get out of the car before you have pulled into the Kiss and Drop Zone. We also remind you that conducting a U-Turn in the Princes Highway and Thomas Street intersection is illegal.

Wason Street (marked with X on map)

We ask that no parents enter Wason Street towards the staff car park. The car park is for staff only and approved authorised access to our disabled parking spaces. There is limited room to turn around once you enter this area. We have many students that use our bottom entrance gate, and it is dangerous to attempt turning around in this space.
