Principals Report

Welcome to Term 4... how are we here already? I'm sure this is one of the most common statements I make. Term 4 is always busy and full of so many activities for the school and our families yet it seems to go by faster than any other term.

School camps

Please check your school bytes account to make sure you've given permission for your child to attend camp (or not) and double check when the final payment is due. You are welcome to make partial payments up until then. Time is getting away and it's not long to go.

A few families have spoken to me already about some concerns they have about their child going on camp - please feel confident to share your concerns if you are worried your child may struggle being away from home or if they have medical or personal needs that we will need to support them with. We are more than happy to work with you to make sure both the parents/carers and child/ren are confident and comfortable to go.

All children will require a sleeping bag. Please don't purchase one if your child doesn't have one. We purchased quite a few last year that students can use.

Melbourne Cup - long weekend

The school will be closed on Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th November for Melbourne Cup. The school has chosen to do this as part of our alternate calendar arrangements where we align with Victorian holidays. Students return 2 days earlier in January to accommodate for this. I know by this time of the year the convenience of your children returning earlier than the rest of NSW isn't fresh in your minds and this long weekend is likely another painful time where families have to manage their work schedules around school closures. Presentation Day and Graduation Night

Presentation Day and the Year 6 Graduation are on Thursday 11th December. More information to follow. For new parents, our Presentation Day is held in the school hall during the day and Graduation Night for the Year 6 families is held at the Moama Bowling Club for dinner.

Quadrangle works - major works

This term we will be having significant works completed in the quadrangle which will be quite disruptive. This will have an impact on pick up and drop off with temporary fencing diverting us around the quadrangle to get into classrooms and the office. There will be some occasions where access to the preschool will be impacted by contractors.

Once we know more about the timeline we will let you know and during works will keep you updated via school bytes text messages about how to access particular areas of the school.

When the quadrangle is completed, the works will continue from the 1D classroom, along the oval end of the office building and out to the bush.

It is expected that these works will take most of Term 4.

Power outage

Essential Energy are completing works on Wednesday 8th and shutting down the power to the school. This was unavoidable. The school will be run by a generator on this day with the driveway and pedestrian gate next to the driveway out of action from Tuesday afternoon until Thursday morning.

2026 Staffing and classes

We will get our 2026 budget at the end of October/early November and from there we will start planning for 2026. Teacher placement and class structure will be communicated once we feel there wont be significant changes. We've been in the position many times where students find out who their teacher is and who is in their class only for this to change and it can be very unsettling for students and their families. The reason for holding off on creating classes until our budget and staffing settles is to ensure students don't experience this.

Students will have step up in December where they will be placed into their 2026 classes, with the 2026 teacher.
