On Tuesday our students had a wonderful time exploring science through a range of hands-on activities with Mrs Jardine and our staff helpers.

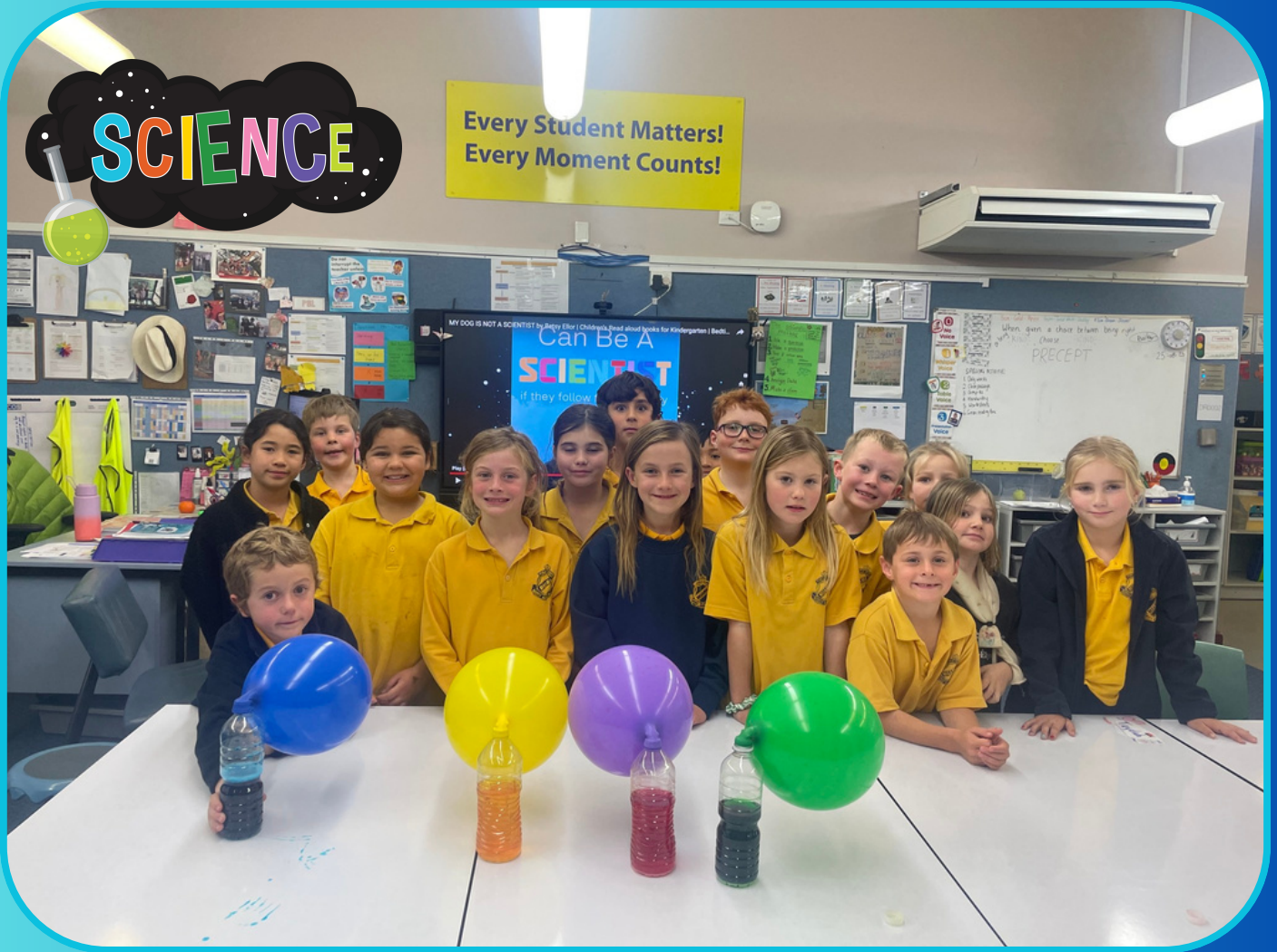
🦋 Our 34 budding scientists created their very own lava lamps, discovering how a solid and a liquid can work together to produce a gas.

Thanks to Mr Mundie for organising these fabulous sessions and Jody Fleming who ran them.

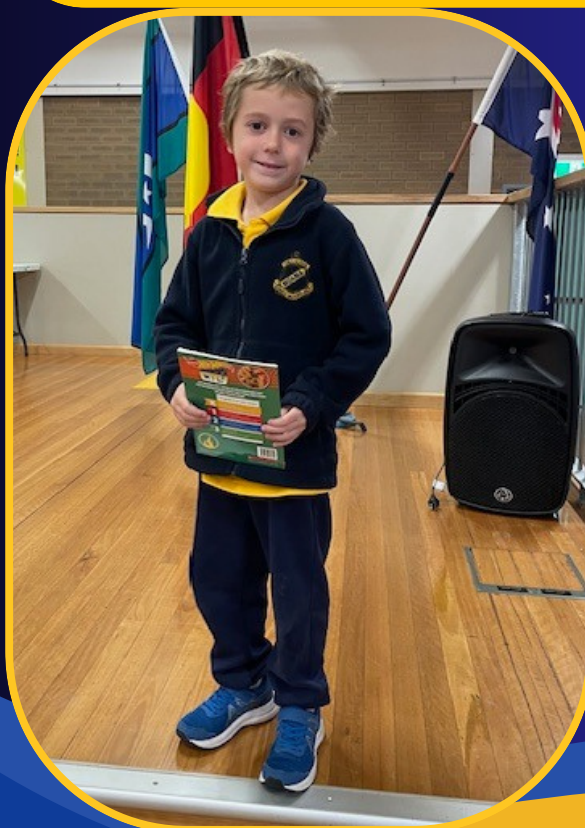
