On Tuesday our students had a wonderful time exploring science through a range of hands-on activities with Mrs Jardine and our staff helpers.


✓ Our 34 budding scientists created their very own lava lamps, discovering how a solid and a liquid can work together to produce a gas.


Science Week was filled with excitement, curiosity, and discovery. We are so proud of how our students embraced the activities and the joy of learning about the world around them!






