## GRIP Leadership Conference (Year 6)

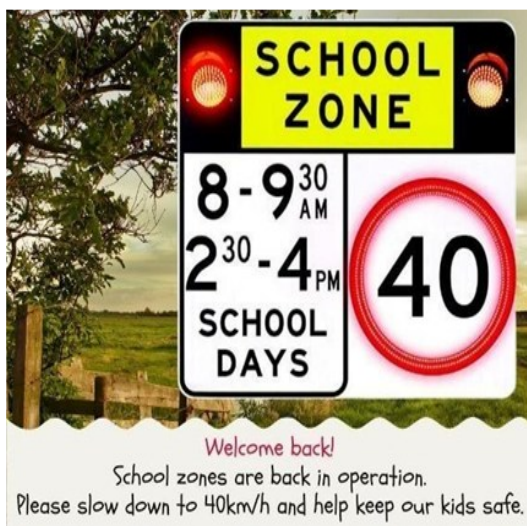

- Accessing parenting programs, offered in groups, individually or online.
- Assistance to begin a support group or playgroup.

- Transition to school workshops and information.
- Natural play and art in the park.
- Working with other organisations to empower families and communities.
