Thank you again to all students, families, and helpers for making our Cross Country event such a highlight on the school calendar. Your support and enthusiasm are what make days like these so special!

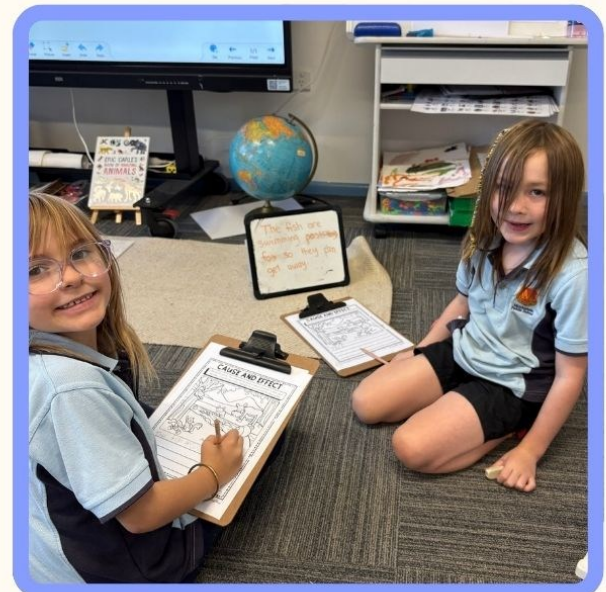
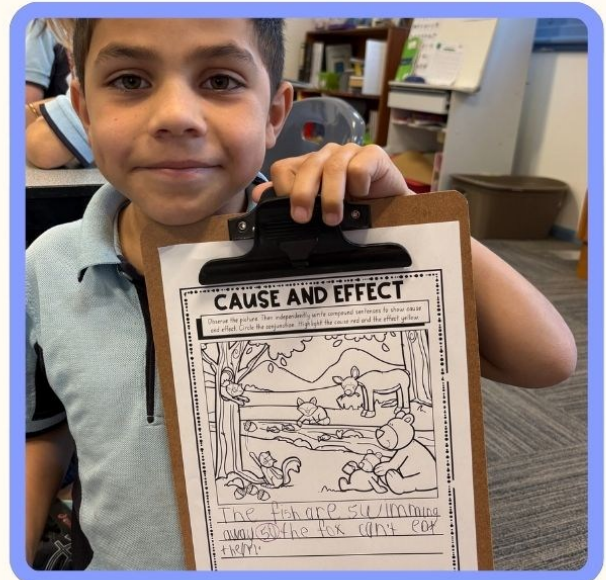
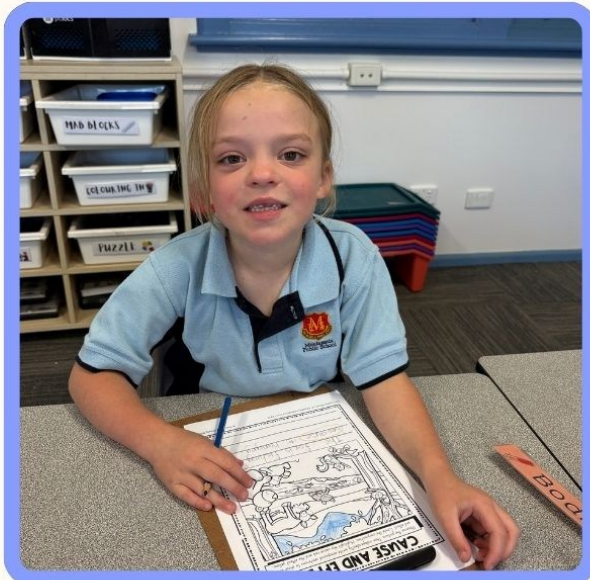

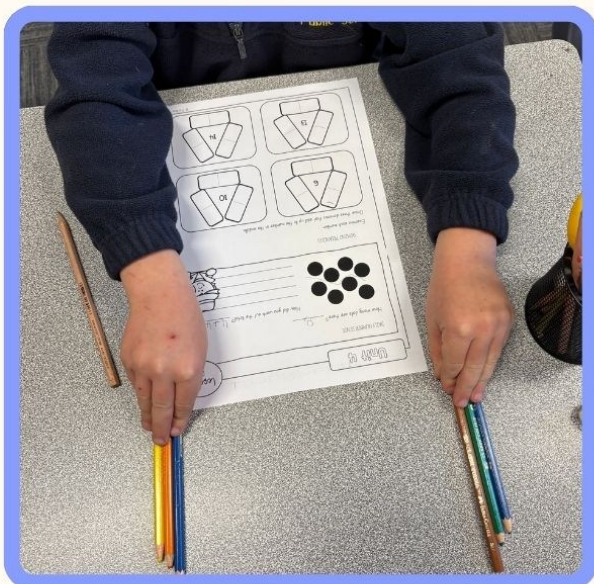
WHAT WE'VE BEEN UP TO!
