

## Public Speaking Competition 2025

During Term 3, Mount Lewis Infants School will be conducting a **Public Speaking Competition**. All students will be encouraged to participate in the competition to refine their presentation skills and develop confidence when speaking in front of an audience.

Students will need to have their speech ready for presentation to their class for **either** week 8 or week 9. After the class competition, students who are selected as class winners will present their speech at the School Public Speaking Competition, in the library in Week 10, on Wednesday 24 September. From the school competition, there will be one winner chosen from each Stage to represent MLIS at the District Competition in Term 4.

#### Speech duration:

Kindergarten: <u>1 minute</u> prepared speech Year 1 & Year 2: <u>2 minute</u> prepared speech

There will be no microphones. Students need to project their voice and may choose any topic of interest suitable for a school audience. **Speeches need to be persuasive**.

Some suggested topics are:

- The best time of the year
- A holiday to remember
- What makes a good friend
- What makes me happy
- My family are special because...
- If I could have a superpower, I would be ... because...
- Everyone should have a pet

Please assist your child by having them practise their speech in front of family members at home. Encourage them to use a clear voice, speak with confidence and at a good speed.

They may write their speech on palm cards or use picture cues to help them remember their speech, however regular eye contact with the audience is very important.

The teachers will be assisting the students to develop their speaking and listening skills and provide them with ongoing feedback throughout the term.

If you have any questions, feel free to ask your class teacher.
