PRINCIPAL'S REVIEW

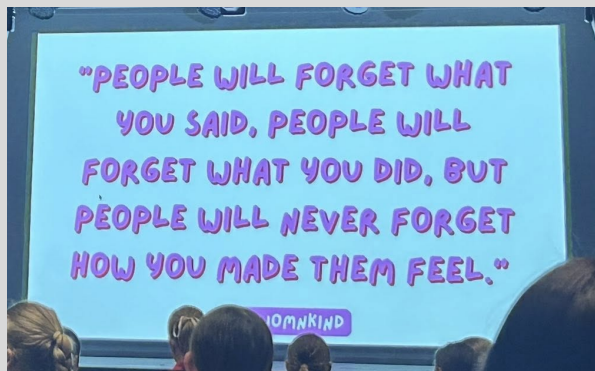
Dear families,
