In the Classroom 2/3 Sharks







Respect: listen and follow instructions in the playground.




To keep our playground safe and happy we need to ensure we listen carefully to teachers and follow playground expectations.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- · 1 onion, finely diced 1 clove garlic, crushed
- 1 stick celery, finely diced
 1kg pumpkin, peeled, de-
- seeded and chopped 1 large potato, peeled and
- 1 large carrot, finely diced
- 2 litres reduced salt chicken
- or vegetable stock • 1/2 teaspoon pepper

- 1. Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium heat.
- 2. Add onion and garlic and cook for 2 minutes or
- Add celery, pumpkin, potato, carrot and stock and bring to the boil.
- 4. Turn heat to low, cover and simmer for 30 minutes or until all vegetables are soft.
- 5. Allow to cool slightly before using a stick blender
- to puree the soup until all vegetables are soft.
- 7. Pour into leak proof containers such as thermos and store in the fridge ready to be added to the
