Don't forget to hand in blue merit awards to the office to receive your gold award.



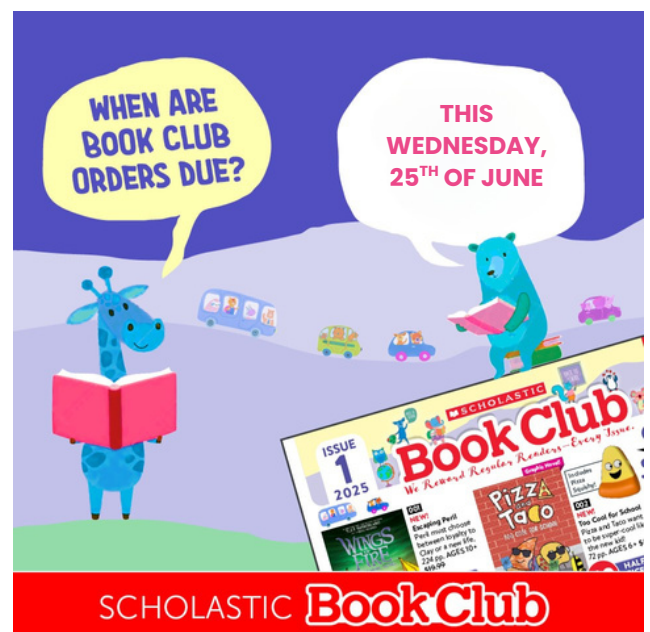
**NAIDOC**

# Whats happening in the TECH HUB



The tech hub is a fantastic space where curiosity, technology, creativity and teamwork come together. This semester our K-1 students have had an introduction to coding through Ozobot lessons. 2/3 Sharks coded microprocessors to make a scissors paper rock game and 3/4 Meerkats coded text to make their names dance, flash and change colour using Scratch Jnr.

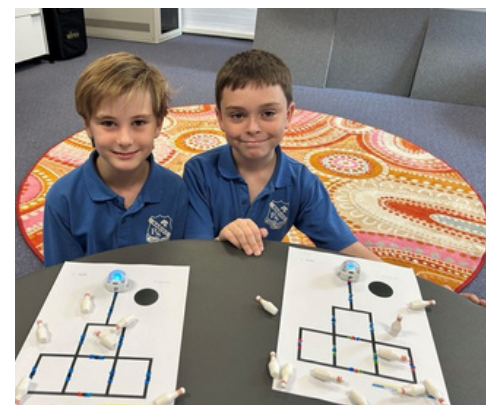
Looking ahead to Semester 2, 1/2 Kookaburras will be coding robots using our school's Lego kits. Primary students will also be exploring hands-on STEM learning with aeroponics kits, which use sensors to monitor plant growth in soil free systems. It's an exciting way to connect technology with sustainability.



Next semester, the creativity continues with the arrival of BOSE podcasting kits, giving our primary students the tools to plan, record and produce their own podcasts. Stay tuned for some fantastic student-created podcasts coming soon! We would also like to give our P & C a big shout out!

Provide energy, but do not provide the nutrients your child needs to grow and develop. They also contain high amounts of fat, added sugar and/or salt.
