Our next Assembly will be on this Wednesday 25 June at 2:15pm, which will be led by K/1 Frogs. Parents and families are welcome to attend.



# Whats happening in the TECH HUB



The tech hub is a fantastic space where curiosity, technology, creativity and teamwork come together. This semester our K-1 students have had an introduction to coding through Ozobot lessons. 2/3 Sharks coded microprocessors to make a scissors paper rock game and 3/4 Meerkats coded text to make their names dance, flash and change colour using Scratch Jnr.

Looking ahead to Semester 2, 1/2 Kookaburras will be coding robots using our school's Lego kits. Primary students will also be exploring hands-on STEM learning with aeroponics kits, which use sensors to monitor plant growth in soil free systems. It's an exciting way to connect technology with sustainability.








These new kits replace our eight year old bots which no longer hold charge.






#### The Uniform Shop
