

To top it off, the SRC students who did our deliveries enjoyed a special tour of the fire and SES trucks, with plenty of smiles when they had a turn with the fire hose!


















In the Classroom with 2/3 Sharks

During Week 6, students in 2/3 Sharks enjoyed a range of exciting activities to celebrate Literacy and Numeracy Week. For literacy, students participated in daily spontaneous reading sessions and even designed their own creative book covers. In numeracy, the class explored measurement by calculating the area of different places around our school, designing their own class flags incorporating elements of symmetry and tessellation, and tested their skills with fun estimation challenges. 

ALL WELCOME

INGREDIENTS

- 2x 400g cans of chickpeas, drained
- 1 tablespoon tahini
- · 2 cloves garlic, crushed
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 tablespoons olive oil
- 4 tablespoons lemon juice
- 3 tablespoons water
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin

DIRECTIONS

- Rinse the chickpeas in cold water and tip into the food processor.
- Add the tahini, garlic, salt, lemon juice, oil, cumin and water.
- Process the mixture until it is fully combined and a smooth consistency.
- Tip the hummus into a bowl or container and refrigerate until ready to serve or be added to the lunchbox.

LUNCHBOX TIP

Add hummus to the lunchbox with raw vegetable sticks or wholegrain crackers!








