A reminder to all parents that the P&c meeting will be held on Tuesday, 13th May at 3.15pm.

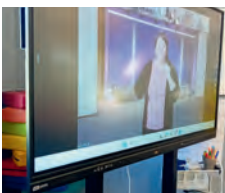
Kudos to our students who have been really persistent in doing their 4 lap jog to train themselves every morning.

Well-Being sessions

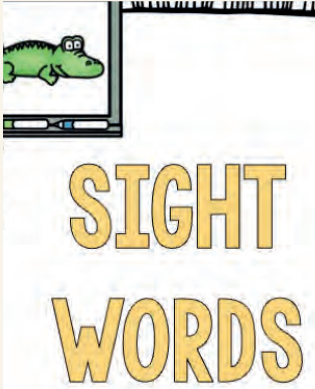

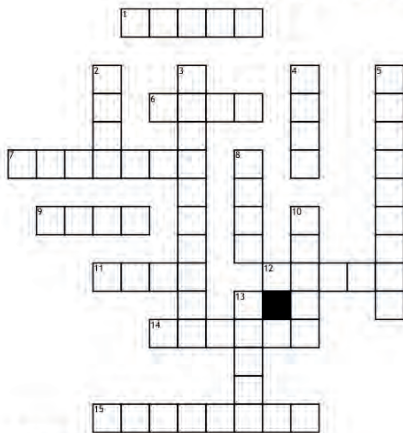
