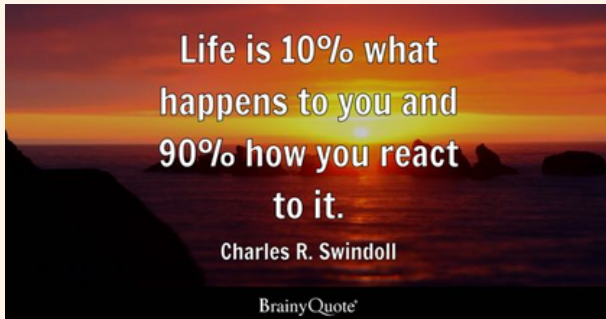

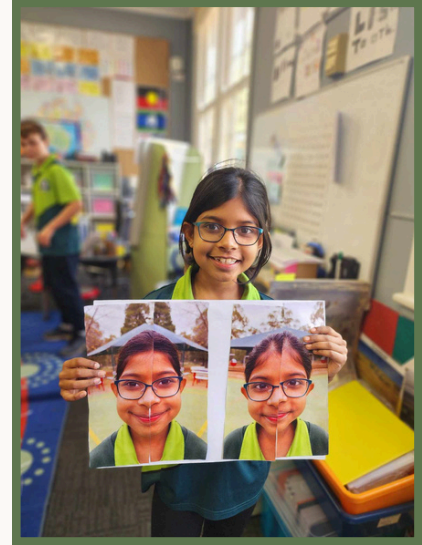

INSIDE THE CLASSROOM

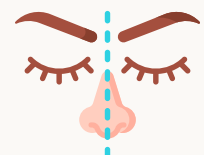


In Maths with Mrs Munro, we looked at symmetry by comparing the right side of our face to the left side of our face.

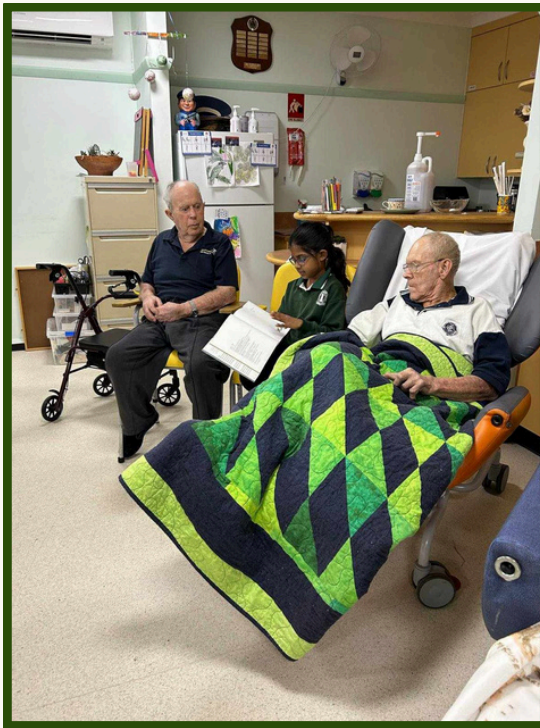
Aizen – Year 4

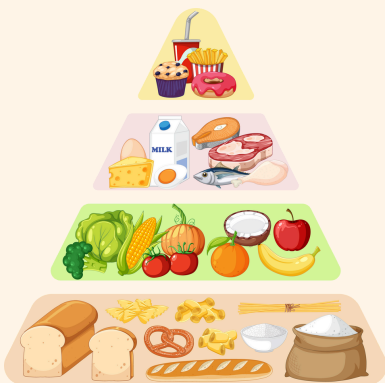

Science

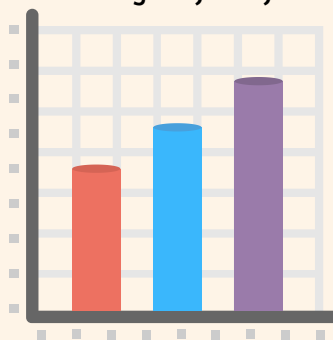
This week we discussed the components of a healthy diet.
