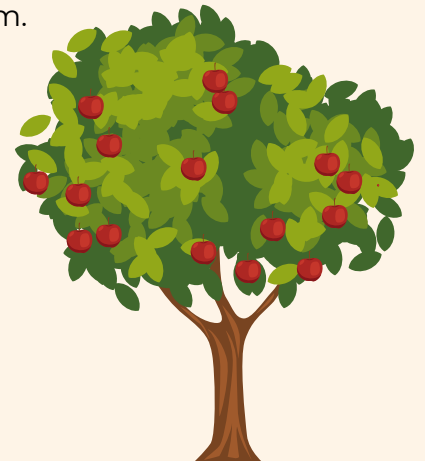
Dear Parents and Carers,

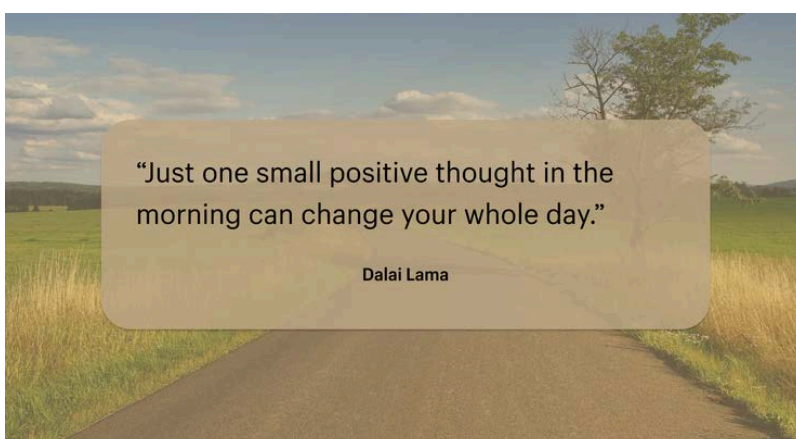

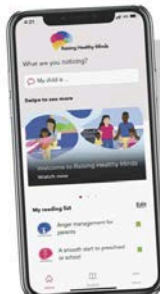


Raising Healthy Minds

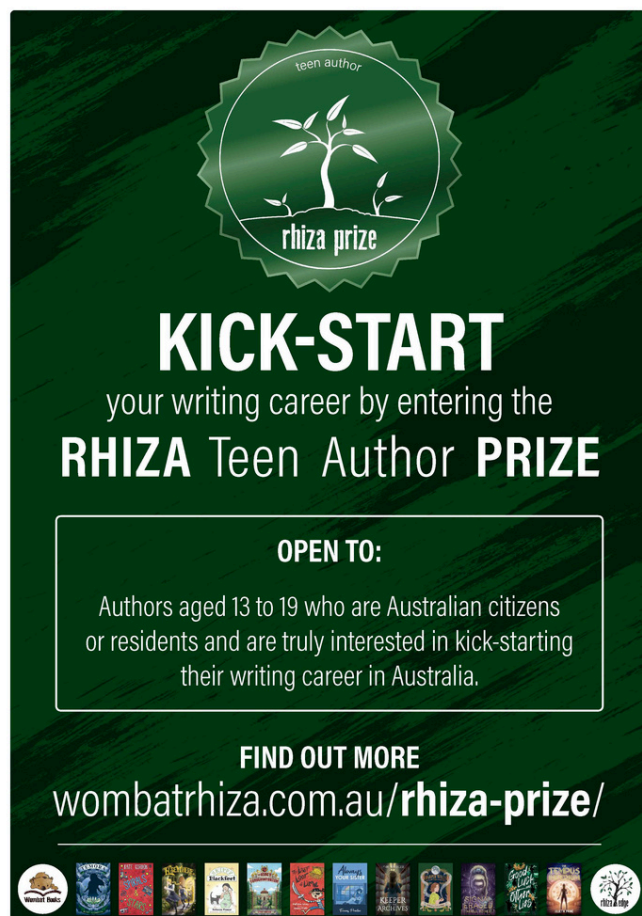

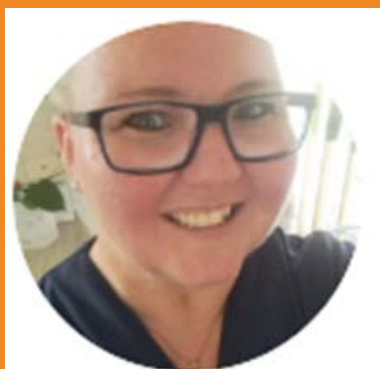
