They will move forward to play another game in Week 6 congratulations to our talented netballers.





CHILD PROTECTION

As part of our commitment to the safety and well-being of all students, we would like to inform you that child protection education is being taught in all classes this term, as part of the Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE) syllabus.

Through age-appropriate lessons, students learn important skills such as recognising safe and unsafe situations, understanding personal boundaries, and knowing how to seek help if they ever feel uncomfortable or at risk. Our aim is to empower children with the knowledge and confidence to protect themselves and to foster a safe and supportive school environment.

Learning Beyond the Classroom: Stage 1 Excursions

Year 1 – Exploring the Past (Term 2)
Linked to their History unit "Past and
Present Family Life", Year 1 students
visited the Wollondilly Heritage Centre in
Term 2. They stepped back in time with
hands-on activities such as butter
churning, laundry washing, and using
pioneer farming tools. Students also
explored Indigenous art, coal mining
practices, and took part in a lesson in a
recreated bush school. It was a fun and
meaningful way to connect with
Australia's early life.

Year 2 – Investigating Water (Term 3)
In Term 3, Year 2 students explored
Warragamba Dam as part of their
Science unit "Earth and Space." They
toured the dam, accessed restricted
areas, and visited the visitor centre to
learn how water is stored, filtered, and
protected. Students examined water
bugs, discovered local wildlife, and
created model environments—gaining a
deeper understanding of water as one
of Earth's most important resources.


