To assist families in meeting the cost of the tour the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$60 per student under

the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion.

Students need to bring either a packed meal or parents may wish to order from the musical menu on the QKR! App via the canteen which will see meals delivered to the holding rooms.


Parents are reminded that for safety and security reasons
