Our bottle recycling is ready for a new year! This was a good source of fundraising in 2024, and we look forward to helping our school and the environment even more this year.


It was decided in the P&C meetings last year that the family rostered on to do canteen for the fortnight would take a load of bottles and cans. Staff are also able to help when needed.
