### Principal's Note

We've had lots of adventures in the past couple of weeks, with our trip to Cooma Public School to spend the day learning and playing with students from Cooma Public, Adaminaby, Bredbo, Michelago and Berridale Public Schools. Like our 'Small School Days' last year, this is an opportunity for students to connect with other children their age whilst engaging in learning activities and allows our staff to connect and learn from each other. Whilst the students were sent off into classes with staff at Cooma Public, some of our teachers were given the opportunity to observe a lesson with an explicit teaching focus and then have a discussion with colleagues, recognising strengths and giving feedback. This will be continued in Week 9 this term, where Cooma Public School staff will be able to come out to some of the smaller schools to observe lessons and possibly send a class or two out to spend a day in a different school. This process will be repeated each term.

#### Clean Up Australia Day at school

We had a great time cleaning up our school and the streets and parkland around the school. We found out that our school is kept very clean and tidy - well done kids! We are also very grateful for our cleaning staff for their effort in keeping the school clean too.

#### First student assembly for the year

NAPLAN assessments for Years 3 and 5 students

Friday 14 March: Reading comprehension

Tuesday 18 March: Maths followed by Conventions of Language

Our whole school attendance rate so far this year is 82%, which is below the average student attendance across the state (90%) and student attendance in our Snowy Monaro network (88.7%).
