Staff went out to Adaminaby Public School and joined in with staff from there, along with Bredbo PS, Berridale PS, Michelago PS and Delegate PS. Sessions were all about recognising potential in students, and there were also sessions for office staff around finance in schools and for support staff (including SLSOs) about risk management for events.

We are gearing up for a busy term and started with a fundraising day at Steampunk selling Devonshire Teas. Congratulations to the P&C on an outstanding effort making and selling scones for the day, the weather was perfect, and it was lovely to see all the different costumes and events.

In a week on Friday 16 May, we will have our Small Schools Athletics day, with Adaminaby, Bredbo, Delegate and Michelago travelling to Nimmitabel for a day of athletics. Piper was tasked with reading 'The Peace Prayer' and Isabella was responsible for reading 'The Ode'. Although Piper became unwell, she read the prayer beautifully at our Term 1 assembly for guests there. Bella read 'The Ode' very clearly. Emilia and Lucy were responsible for laying the wreath on behalf of the school.




### Attendance Update Weeks 1-2, Term 2
