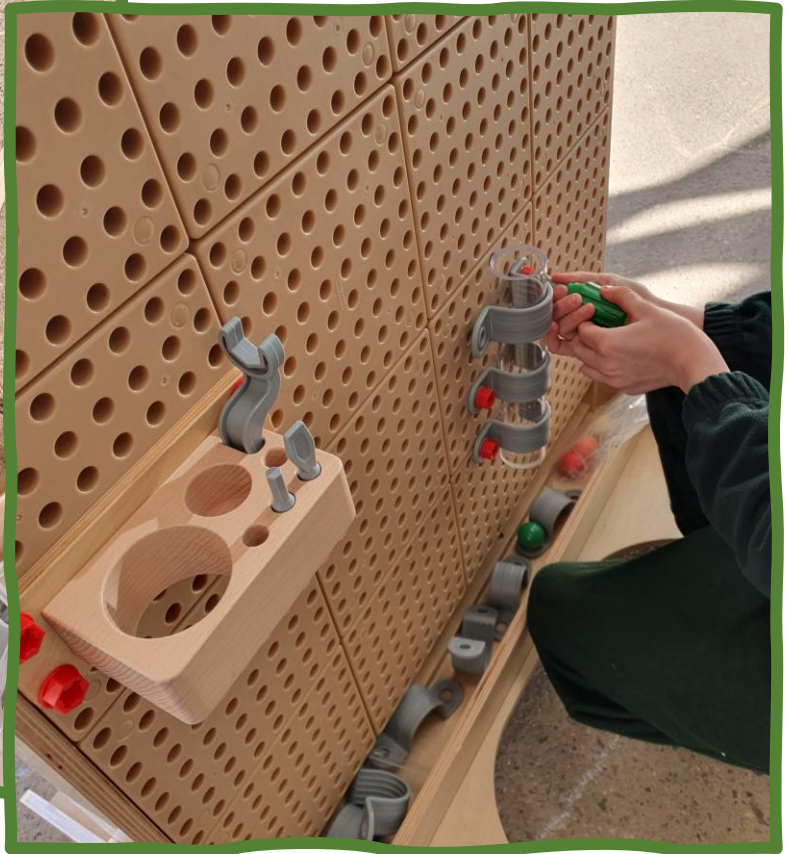
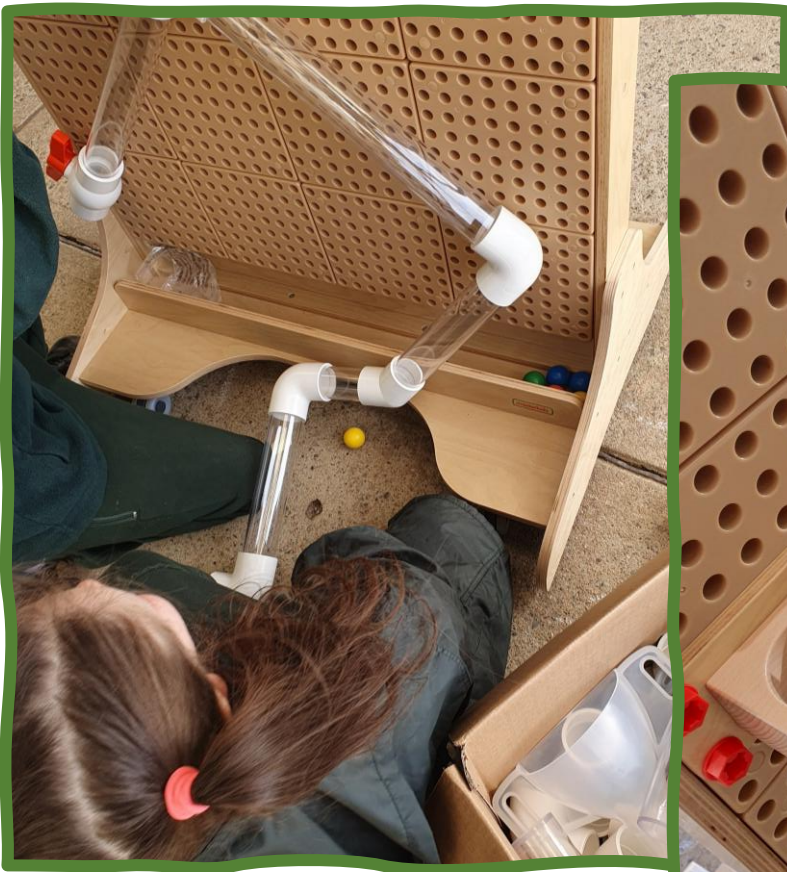

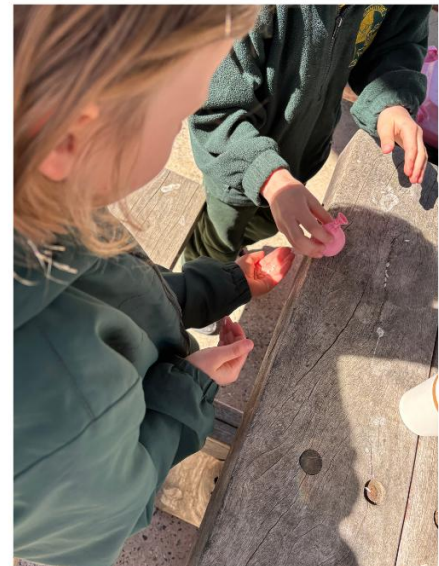


Year 1 students have seen 100% attendance in Term 3!

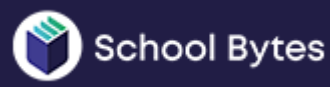
