Principal Report

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Firstly, I would like to remind everyone of our current school reward system whereby students collect merits each week for regular attendance, wearing the correct school uniform, focusing on learning in the classroom and showing positive behaviour in the classroom and playground. 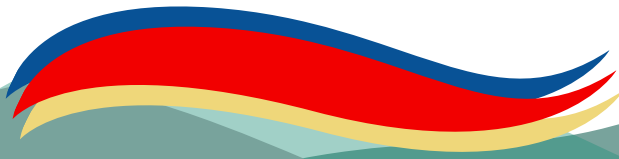

2025 CWA OAKLANDS NEWS MARCH

- Members are excited to be bringing to Oaklands in partnership with NSW Government (FREE) a STEPPING ON program aimed at preventing falls. See the attached flyer for details please register your interest by phoning 02 5924 5292 at Kinetic Medicine Corowa.
- Oaklands branch won 3rd Prize overall at the recent Murray Group Handicraft Day. Missing 2nd place by ½ a point. Lorraine Marcus scored very highly. Heather Kerr has a silk pillowcase going to State for judging at Wagga Wagga in May.
- Bush Babies Campaign is being supported by CWA of NSW to appeal for Bundled Funding for Maternity Care + other health items. Please sign ePetition to Legislative Assembly which is open until 24th April. Maternity services are being cut severely.
- The cervical cancer National Screening Program reduces illness and death from same. Women and people with a cervix aged 25 to 74 years of age are invited to have a Cervical Screening Test every 5 years through their healthcare provider.
- Australian research into Ovarian Cancer has discovered and patented a blood-based biomarker test for early-stage detection. The ultrasensitive test has been validated in 500 women with 90% accuracy. This is called CA-125 blood test.
- An ultrasound will NOT pick the cancer. A CAT scan will catch it in very late stages. If you have serious concerns please ask for the blood test which has been available since early 2024. CWA of NSW sponsored this Australian research for 3 consecutive years.

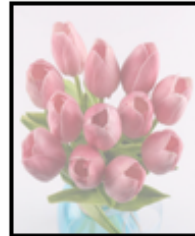
