K-6 Science with Mrs Southam


Through many investigations, Kindergarten have been making floating bugs, foil boats, marshmallow catapults and animal parachutes to explore forces in water, on the land and in the air.













Years 3 to 6 have had weekly challenges to build their understanding of simple machines (lever, wedge, screw, pulley, wheel and axle, incline plain). A big "Congratulations" goes to Henry and Oliver for their perseverance in attempting to make a working Archimedes Screw – it wasn't easy and after 3 weeks we admitted defeat, learning from our failures that what looks good on paper might not be so in reality. I am extremely proud of ALL students in Years 3 to 6. Our students consistently have high expectations to learn, and it is reflected in the quality of their work.





This term Years 3 to 6 will apply their knowledge from Term 3 into a Rube Goldberg machine challenge. Each group must incorporate all 6 simple machines into a chain reaction, that will either: crack an egg, turn off an alarm, pop a balloon, shut a door, ring a bell or water a plant. We can't wait to get started!

Extension Writing Group with Mrs Southam

Our extension writing group has been working exceptionally hard understanding literary devices that build tension and suspense. They are currently writing a 19 chapter Choose Your Own Adventure mini-novel, set in a mysterious mansion. Part of their learning has involved peer feedback on the initial writing plan.


