SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Petersham Public School has a uniform policy which requires students to wear the school uniform every day. The uniform is non-gendered and can be worn in each student's preferred configuration from the following items:

Top - under layer

- Gold short sleeve polo shirt with school crest
- Gold long sleeve polo shirt with school crest
- Gold tee shirt with school crest
- Navy and white tunic
- Navy tee shirt with school crest
- House shirts with school crest on Fridays

Top and Bottom - outer layer

- Navy jumper with school crest
- Navy jacket with school crest
- Navy hoodie with school crest
- Navy shorts
- Navy skort
- Navy pants
- Navy track pants
- Navy tights/stockings*

Footwear

- Black leather shoes or black sports shoes*
- White socks*

Hat

- Navy broad-brimmed hat with school crest
- Navy beanie

Optional: bag

- Navy backpack with school crest
- Library bag with school crest
- Excursion bag with school crest
