SOME IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR YEAR 10

Students Seeking Exemption:

From the beginning of Week 5 many students may be seeking exemption for the remainder of the school year. Whilst this a good time for students to gain further hours in existing roles and so on please be reminded of the rules around seeking an ex-emption:

- i) You must provide a signed letter on official letterhead from your employer/course provider. This letter must indicate that your employer understands there are some dates that you will need to be at school (these dates are listed below)
- ii) You must provide a signed letter from a parent or caregiver
- iii) You must provide these documents to Mrs Maricic

If all documentation is in order, you will then be provided with an exemption on the understanding that you will attend school on the following dates:

6th and 7th November: *All My Own Work*. This is compulsory for ALL NSW students who are undertaking Stage 6. Any student who is absent on these days will have to complete a catch up at a later date.

21st November: *Wyndham Orientation Day*. All students who are going to Wyndham must attend in full school uniform. Failure to attend may endanger your position.

21st November: *Wyndham Orientation Evening for Parents* 6pm- 9pm

6th December: Year 10 Formal at Novotel Norwest. Red carpet arrivals will begin at 6:00pm

7th December: Year 10 Graduation Rehearsal at 9am. Full school uniform including black, leather shoes must be worn. Students can sign out after 10.45am

8th December: Year 10 Graduation at 9am. Full school uniform including black, leather shoes must be worn

Students who do not gain an exemption are expected to attend school each day, in full school uniform, with all the equipment required for learning. They are expected to undertake all learning activities and to follow the SMART code.
