#### **FEES/ FINANCE**

## **BUSES**

Parents will often contact the school to raise concerns that they have about bus lateness, the conduct of bus drivers, bus drivers driving past students waiting at stops and so on. Parents are encouraged, as are the students, to call Busways directly and lodge your complaints or concerns. We also have occasional concerns and we raise these directly with the bus company. Once again Busways has expressed the need for students to tap on and tap off. Failure to tap on and tap off leads to a reduction in the number of services or a complete cancellation as there is no real data about how many passengers are using a service.
