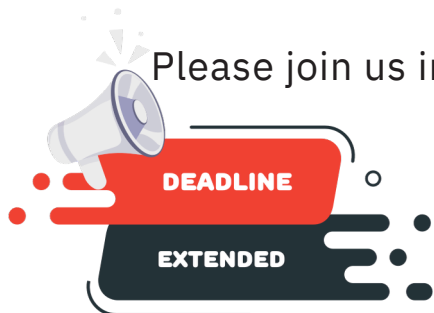


Raglan Public School is Celebrating its 155th Anniversary in 2025!
