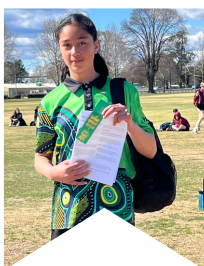
TENNIS-SPORTING SCHOOLS

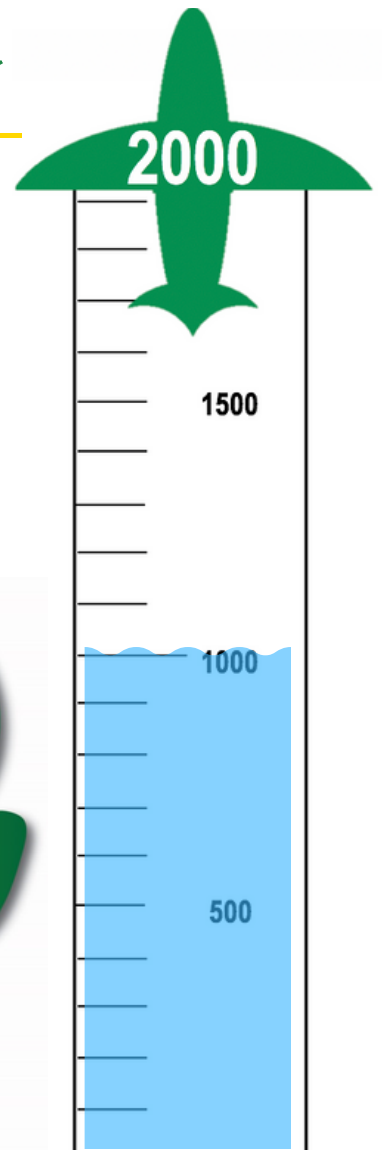
