We're also proud to share that our Year 1 students have completed the Phonics Screener with outstanding results, as a result of our strong focus on phonics in K-2.

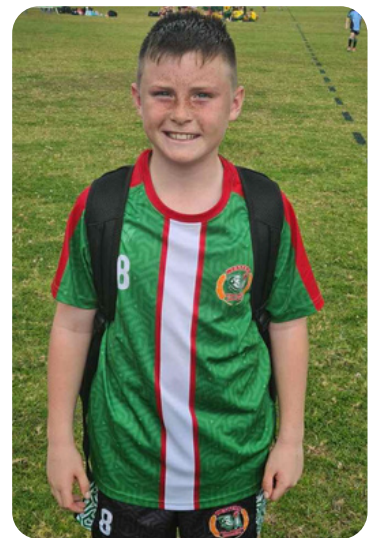

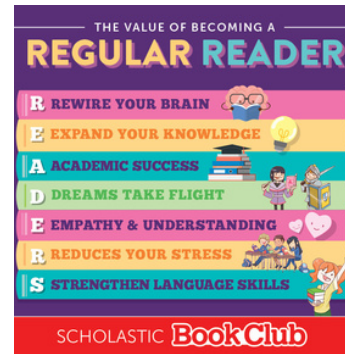


BOOK CLUB

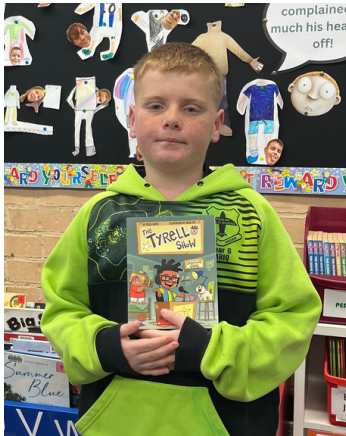

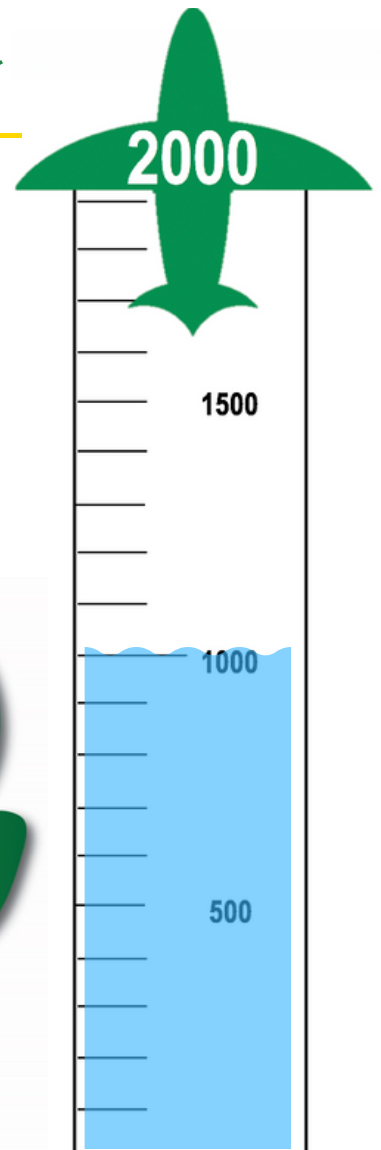
